During the most intense days of the fire, when thousands were displaced from their homes, MSBC became an evacuation centre, offering free lodging and meals to those who were in need. Around 20 different individuals were accommodated during that week, while the boys camp had to be cancelled. Even this past week the growing fire threat caused the camp directors to also cancel the last couple of days of the Day Camp for small children.

We have just finished a busy weekend at the Labour Day conference here in 100 Mile House. The conference speakers included Mercer Armstrong, Scott DeGroff, Rob Brennan, Josh George and myself. The ministry was perhaps the most personally challenging messages I have ever heard in my Christian life.
